Post Operative Care Instructions For Nipple Reconstruction

Bolster Dressing Care

- 1. When you wake up from surgery you will have a bolster that will resemble a small yellow squash sewn on to your breast. Keep this pressure dressing that was applied today in place until Dr. Coberly removes the dressing at your post-op appointment. You will need to purchase nipple pads that will be used as your dressing following your post-op appointment. These can be purchased at any drugstore.
- 2. You will need to be very careful not to smash your dressings / nipples. Try to sleep on your back or side, not your stomach.
- 3. If bleeding occurs apply constant gentle pressure for twenty minutes or until bleeding ceases. If pressure is not effective contact our office.
- 4. On the day following surgery you may shower from head to toe. DO NOT soak your wound in a bath. Clean water running down is ok, try not to completely saturate your dressing.
- 5. Mild redness around the suture line is expected, however, should you develop severe swelling, redness and/or pus at the wound site, or if you develop a fever of 101 or above please notify us immediately..
