

Areolar and Nipple Repigmentation Post-op

Welcome to the final stages of your reconstruction, at this point Dr. Coberly has discussed your final choice: Areolar and nipple repigmentation.

The Art of Implanting Pigment in to the Areolar/nipple Complex.

This procedure will produce the visual touch to an already finished breast giving you back the appearance of a natural looking breast. You and your areolar specialist, along with the recommendations of Dr. Coberly will draw and construct your new areolar placement. Then, we will choose natural looking breast pigment colors to compliment your other areolar and nipple complex or recreate the bilateral areolar complex with colors of your choice and desire. In the comfort of our office we will produce the final and completed stages of your already beautiful reconstruction.

Frequently asked questions about this process.

Will there be any pain and discomfort with the procedure?

We will first numb the area so that the process is comfortable for you and continue to numb the area as we treat the area.

Does my insurance cover the Repigmentation?

Most insurance's will cover this procedure or we will assist you with the paper work for reimbursement for self-pay clients.

Is there a long healing process?

It will take about one week for the repigmentation to be complete, and one month for the final results to show.

Are there any restrictions in my daily activities?

Yes, you will have some restrictions, no swimming or hot tub, no sauna or tanning beds for the first two weeks.
